Guest Speaker

Malalai Joya, Afghanistan



At 28 years old, Malalai Joya is the youngest and most famous of all the women in the Afghan parliament. In a way her very presence in the parliament is a powerful symbol of change; a woman who had to work in secret in underground schools in Herat during the Taliban time is now able to speak out against her enemies in the parliament.

She rose to fame at the end of 2003, when she made a speech attacking the warlords who still hold the balance of power in Afghanistan. Since her historic speech, Malalai Joya has survived assassination attempts and constant denunciations.

Funds raised by UNIFEM Australia at IWD events in 2007 will support a major UNIFEM Pacific project to assist members of regional networks and other selected organisations in their work to End Violence Against Women. The project will offer leadership training, and build the capacity of women's organisations across all Pacific nations to initiate, design and conduct projects and strategies through the UN Trust Fund to Eliminate Violence Against Women.

The project will involve focused training for NGO leaders in an extended regional workshop in mid 2007, with mentoring and practical on the ground project support.

UNIFEM Australia will also continue to contribute to the global UN Trust Fund to end Violence Against women.
